Note:

- » 1 hour of CAS can at most cover editing/reviewing 2 long essays (500 words or above) OR 3 short essays (100-300 words) OR 1 resume OR 1 application OR 1 interview
- For essays, it's about maximum of 1000 words per hour
- If needing to work on essay from start to finish, 1 long essay will take at least 3 hrs and 1 short essay will take at least 2 hours
- Format:
 - » First 5 minutes will be spent on getting to know the student, and then together with the counselor, they will plan how to spend the rest of the time based on what the student brings and what's a priority

HOW DO I PREPARE FOR PSAT?

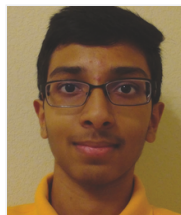
